Centennial High School KEY CLUB INFORMATION SHEET

Membership Requirements:

- 1. The application, medical authorization form, and dues are to be turned in at the same time. The dues are *non-refundable* for all accepted members.
- 2. All Key Club applicants must have a GPA of 2.0 or better to be in the club. Any student whose GPA falls below the guideline will be on probation until the grades improve, which means no voting during meetings and limited abilities for trips, etc. Grades and Dean's office checks will be done on a quarterly basis.
- 3. Everyone whose application is accepted will be expected to begin attending all weekly meetings. **Only exception:** If you are in a sport or another extracurricular activity held on the same day then you may attend only or at least one meeting per month; however, you have to be active in the club.
- 4. No person is officially in Key Club until he/she has the minimum quarterly hours.
- 5. Members are expected to participate in all fundraisers. The money raised will be reserved for events throughout the year, charities, the Key Club District Convention, Fall Rally, and more.
- 6. Members should learn all Key Club cheers. Our division is known for spirit, so let's keep it!

Quarterly Requirements:

- 1. Every member must accumulate the minimum amount of hours each quarter: **15 hours per quarter.** At least **half** of the hours from every quarter need to be Key Club related.
- 2. All members must reapply yearly. Members in good standing will be given priority for the next year.
- 3. Hour sheets are YOUR responsibility. They will be given out monthly and it is your responsibility to keep track of them. Keep in mind that a signature from the supervising individual of an event is required. One should be completed and turned in on a monthly basis. They will be checked.
- 4. A member will be deducted **one hour** if he/she does not attend an event after signing-up to do it. Giving your word and saying you will attend an event and not showing up is unacceptable. This is not fair to your club.

Consequences for not attending meetings:

- 1. Warning that hours have not been turned in.
- 2. Probation if problem continues (probation last for four meetings).
- 3. After two months of non-attendance, the member will be subject to termination from the club and cannot reapply the following year. He or she will not be eligible for scholarships or awards which would come from Key Club or any part of the K Family.
